

## **Summary of The 12:1 Principle**

### **A Lifestyle of Worship**

The New Testament gives little instruction regarding the use of music in the life of a person and the church. Rather, biblical instruction centers on character development that results in a life style of worship. This course discusses the “living sacrifice” directive in terms of when believers meet together (corporately) and in the private times (when God is watching). It will include assignments with the goal of preparing God's people to be worshipers according to Romans 12:1. In this quarter the living sacrifice will be considered in three seminars.

“The living sacrifice” can be defined as living in submission to God and dying to the flesh. Submission to God will have a very distinct appearance.
